What happens at the Club?

This year we are following a programme called "Champions" which uses the analogy of the Olympic games to explore how Jesus 'ran the race' for God. It starts off with the story of Jesus as a young boy in the Temple, and over five days presents five themes that every good athlete hopes to achieve: Direction, avoid Distraction, Dedication, Determination, and finally, Decoration. With Bible stories and the Olympic theme, children will experience drama, games, songs, puppets, crafts, memory verses, quizzes, sports, silly fun and much more!
